REMOVING THE “TARES” FOR THE HARVEST TO FLOURISH

AMAZING TIMES

The prophet Daniel says concerning our times that *“those who are wise will shine like the brightness of the heavens.”* (Daniel 12:3) As we celebrate the coming of Jesus - the Light of the World may we too be lights to those around us in these difficult times. Through Him God reconciled the world to Himself. It remains simply for all men to hear, believe and be reconciled to God.

“God and sinners reconciled” is the message that rings throughout the world at this time, bringing hope and life to millions.

We now live in the times that Daniel spoke about - *the end of the age*. The return of Jerusalem to Jewish control (Luke 21:24) is the sign that we are in this period, which Jesus calls *“the time of the harvest”*(Matthew 13:39).

“The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man that sowed good seed in his field: but while men slept, his enemy came and sowed TARES also among the wheat, and went away.

But when the blade sprang up and brought forth fruit, TARES appeared also.

And the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, did you not sow good seed in thy field? Why then has it TARES?

*And he said to them, ‘An enemy has done this.’ And the servants say to him, ‘Should go and gather them up?’ But he said, No, lest while you gather up the TARES, you root up the wheat with them. Let both grow together until the harvest, and **IN THE TIME***

OF THE HARVEST I will say to the reapers, Gather up first the TARES, and bind them in bundles to burn them; but gather the wheat into my barn. (Matthew 13)

According to this parable, at **THE END OF THE AGE** – i.e. the generation in which we now live – the angels (ministers visible and invisible) will be dispatched to remove the “TARES” from the wheat field.

Wheat and TARES have been permitted to grow side by side until now. This parable speaks of a reformed Christianity at the end of the age. This is now the time for ministers, Bible teachers, pastors and evangelists to begin to recognize and remove the “TARES” from the field.

Our generation is being given the responsibility not only to sow the seed of God’s word but to lovingly, yet firmly, point out and remove the works of the enemy. Doctrines and practices, contrary to the word of God, that have long been permitted in the church will be exposed and removed.

Within a generation of the apostles, the message, glory and power of the early church was quickly diminished by the sowing of false teachings, doctrines and practices. Throughout the centuries many more “TARES” were sown so that by the time of the 21st century Christianity had become greatly distorted and choked by its own ungodly traditions.

The time of reform is upon us. Not only will the word be sown throughout the world but also the false traditions and practices will be

recognized and removed. Churches that do not deal with these “TARES” will die or become fossils.

IDENTIFYING SOME TARES

Many features of today’s Christianity would have been alien to the early Christians, and will be removed.

Some examples are:

- The use of political power to try to advance the agenda of the kingdom of God.
- The failure to proclaim freedom from the power of sin as well as from the penalty of sin
- Failure to emphasize the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Cessationism - the false teaching that the supernatural and miraculous activity of the Holy Spirit is optional since we now have the Bible to instruct us
- Replacement Theology – the teaching that the Church has replaced Israel
- Ignoring the covenant with Abraham (still in operation) and the blessings made available to all believers through the work of Jesus,
- The making of pastors and church officers into a priestly class and mediators between the people and God.
- The failure to practice the priesthood and ministry of all believers,
- The exaltation of Mary, the mother of Jesus, into a virtual God and mediator
- Clerical celibacy,
- Free Masonry & Secret Lodges among believers.
- The reduction of Holy Communion to a religious ritual instead of a practical way open for all believers to appropriate and activate the benefits of the New Covenant.
- The use of titles such as ‘Reverend’, ‘Doctor’ ‘Pastor’ to separate the body of Christ into first and second class believers.
- The commercialization of Christianity through marketing techniques rather than

looking to God in faith and prayer to supply our every need

- Failure to teach believers how to release themselves from demonic and tormenting influences
- Failure to create a culture of evangelism and instead making evangelism a prerogative of paid professionals.
- Can we really expect revival renewal harvest and restoration without addressing these issues within our church?

A new harvest of righteousness will emerge as the TARES that have become embedded in Christianity and accepted as part of our true tradition are identified and deliberately removed. We will then “shine like the brightness of the heavens.” (Daniel 12:3) and be the ‘light of the world.’

THE EXACT DATE OF JESUS PREDICTED

The most astonishing quality of the Bible that makes it completely different from any other book is that it predicts events with exact chronological precision before they happen. This is the signature of God and the evidence of His divine authorship.

The most important event in world history is the coming of the Messiah. This is the great defining moment in History when God sent His only begotten Son, to be the Messiah, to take on Himself the sins of the world and to restore us to His favor and blessing. Paul says that God sent Jesus "at the right time." (Galatians 4:4) His coming was foretold in detail so that no one can be in doubt about who the true Messiah is.

- **1000 years before His birth, His genealogy** (that He would be a descendant of David of the tribe of Judah) was given to David and Samuel (Psalm 89; 2 Sam 6)
- **700 hundred years before His birth, the location** of His birth - Bethlehem - was given to Micah. (Micah 5:2)
- **500 years before His birth, the precise time** of His coming was given to Daniel (Daniel Chapter 9)

In Daniel's amazing prophecy (Dan. 9) God states that the Messiah will complete His mission of providing atonement, and be killed in the last seven years of a 490 year time period beginning from the issuing of a decree to restore and build Jerusalem.

"Seventy weeks are decreed upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most holy one (The Messiah).

Know, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto THE MESSIAH, THE PRINCE, shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks (i.e. 69

weeks of years - 483 years) and after the threescore and two weeks The anointed One (The Messiah) one be cut off, and shall have nothing." (Daniel 9)

This prophecy predicts with astonishing supernatural accuracy when the Messiah will come on the scene. He will be anointed, bring in everlasting righteousness, a covenant, an end to sacrifices and be killed in the last seven years of a 490 year time frame from a decree to restore and build Jerusalem. A decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem was issued by Artaxerxes I in 458 BC. The 490-year time period began therefore on that year and ended in the year 33 A.D. (458 BC + 490 years = 33 A.D. Remember there is no year 0) With precise timing Jesus' birth and mission was accomplished in the exact 490-year period, which ended in 32 A.D.

The wise men from the East (Persia) were familiar with Daniel's prophecy. They also understood that as a priest the Messiah would have to be 30 years old before He commenced His ministry. So they were looking for His birth to take place at least 30 years before the 490 year period ended and for astronomical signs to confirm the date.

The Messiah had to come in this time period. No one else can fit this description - only Jesus. Jesus is the great leader sent by God to lead Israel and all nations back to the care of God, our Heavenly Father.

As we recall these events

- LET US TREASURE OUR BIBLES
- LET US ADORE HIM,
- LET US FOLLOW HIM AND
- SERVE HIS INTERESTS.

NOTE: It is sad that the impact of this amazing prophecy of Daniel has been lost to modern Christianity because of a false tradition that has hidden its truth. This amazing prophecy of the time of the coming of the Messiah has been twisted by many from being a prophecy about the coming of the true Messiah into a prophecy about the coming of an antichrist.
